

**“Children and Salvation: Our Role and Responsibility”**  
**Numbers 13:25-33; 14:1-4, 26-33**

**1. There is only one \_\_\_\_\_ for salvation.** (Proverbs 14:12, 21:2-3; Matthew 7:13-14; John 14:6)

- a. A child’s level of \_\_\_\_\_ will be different than an adult.
- b. There are basic principles we must understand for \_\_\_\_\_.
  - i. God loves me and has a plan for my life.  
(Psalm 139:13-14; Jeremiah 31:3)
  - ii. I have sinned and am separated from God.  
(Isaiah 59:2; Romans 5:12, 6:23a)
  - iii. Jesus paid the penalty for my sin and offers me eternal life.  
(Romans 5:8, Romans 6:23; 1 Peter 3:18)
  - iv. I must accept His free gift through repentance and confession. (Acts 3:19; Romans 10:9-10; 1 John 1:9)

**2. We are not able to gain salvation in our own \_\_\_\_\_.**  
(Numbers 13:31, 14:9; Psalm 18:2-3; Acts 4:12)

**3. We have to ask ourselves the question: “Will I \_\_\_\_\_ God in \_\_\_\_\_, or will \_\_\_\_\_ try to run the show in my family?”**  
(Numbers 14:3; 32-33; Hebrews 11:6)

**Our Daily Walk:**

1. Exercise spiritually: a) **pray** (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18), b) **read and obey God’s Word** (Psalm 119:11, 105), c) **tell others about Jesus** (Acts 1:8), d) **be an active member of your church** (Acts 2:44-46; Hebrews 10:25)
2. Pray for your children (salvation, walk with Lord; their future spouse, etc...)
3. Share Jesus with your children at their level of understanding (don’t push for an empty profession, but allow them to voice what God is doing in their lives)
4. Trust God and His timing
5. Model the Gospel message (Luke 9:23)
