Summer Missions is a practical look at discipleship here in Missouri and wherever we go. Without biblical Missions, Evangelism, and Discipleship we are truly missing the point of being a follower of Jesus.

Summer Missions is a 10-week internship (May 28-August 3, 2019) made possible through the Missouri Missions Offering. You will be assigned with Pastor Michael Wilbanks to serve and grow in a variety of ways throughout the summer. This will include covering the above core values with Pastor Michael on a weekly basis. This internship exists to help you grow in your personal relationship with Jesus and get a glimpse into your mentor's life and ministry. We hope this will be a helpful time to help establish you in a place of confidence and boldness in following Jesus wherever you go; we hope to help you make the transition to what it means to follow Jesus in your next steps and for some of you during big life changes.

Your summer will include serving as a camp leader at Super Summer, reaching out to your community, putting together Bible camps, providing administrative support, facilitating Bible studies, among other things. The possibilities are endless, but some keys are to be flexible, available to be used by God and for God to work through you, and to spend time deepening personal spiritual disciplines: meditating on God's Word (reading, studying, reflecting, journaling), prayer, evangelism, tithing, serving, praising God, and fasting. The goal is to be more like Jesus each new day and in each moment. It is not simply about us, but so that all may hear the true Gospel of Jesus.

You will receive a Tentative Calendar for this summer from Pastor Michael.

Most weeks will require about 20 hours of allotment, some a little more some a little less. You will create a tentative weekly schedule with Pastor Michael that works for you both. Let's pray for a summer passionately following in Jesus' footsteps and not simply a summer job or going through the motions of doing good things.

General weekly breakdown:

4 Hours Group Discipleship twice weekly

4 hours Personal Reading/Deeper Bible Study/Material/Reflection

8 hours Administration/Planning Events & Activities

4 hours Evangelism & Prayer (Outreach to the community)
